Conditional Clause	CONDITION (If-clause)	RESULT
1st	<b>Present Simple</b> If I study,	<b>Will/won't</b> I will pass
2nd	<b>Past Simple</b> If he had money,	<b>Would /Wouldn't</b> he would go to China.
