He / She walks

He / She likes

He / She ties

He / She lives

He / She crosses



NEGATIVE

He / She ~~doesn't~~ walk

He / She ~~doesn't~~ like

He / She ~~doesn't~~ tie

He / She ~~doesn't~~ live

He / She ~~doesn't~~ cross



We add **-s** to the verb to form the 3rd person singular.

For example: He/She walks

we add **-es** to verbs that end in -ss. For example: crosses
