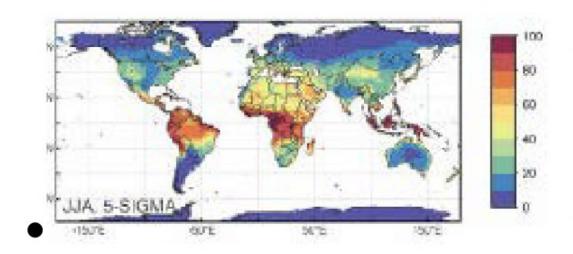
Heatwaves
