Spiders

There are more than 30,000 different kinds of spiders in the world! Every spider has eight legs and eight eyes, and two sections of their body: the cephalothorax (sef-uh-lo-thor-ax) and abdomen. One of the most interesting things about spiders is the webs they build. They use sticky silk threads from spinnerets to spin their webs. Insects get trapped in the webs, the spider wraps it in more silk, and then the spider is able to use their fangs to kill the insect and eat it. Many webs are circular and catch flying insects, but some spiders also weave webs on the ground to catch crawling insects.
