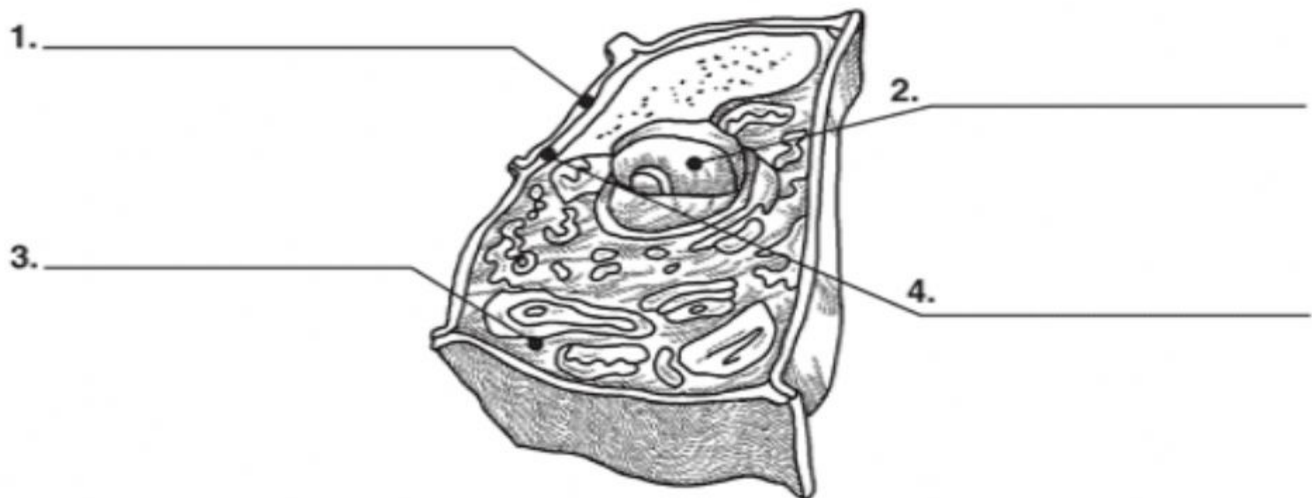


HOW ARE LIVING THINGS ORGANIZED?
