

- An organ system is a group of organs with related functions.
- They work together to perform body functions.
- Organs are made up by the union of several tissues that are organized and work together.
 - A living thing: human beings, animals, plants.
 - Living things can carry out the <u>vital functions</u>.
- Tissues are groups of similar cells.
- They <u>work together</u> and perform a function,
- All living things are made up of <u>cells</u>.
- Cells are the <u>smallest</u> parts and the <u>basic</u> <u>building blocks</u> of all living things.
