Our guide reveals the little things you can do to help reduce waste at Christmas.

Paper

If all the wrapping paper we throw away was put in a line, it can reach all the way to the Moon - that's a lot of paper! But it's very easy to recycle, lots of waste pickers will take it away for you or take it to a recycling bank in supermarkets or your school.



Why not try giving presents in gift bags? That way you can reuse them again next year and save on paper!

Christmas Trees

If you have a real Christmas tree it's a great thing to recycle. There's lots recycling companies who can collect it for you. It can then be shredded and used as compost to help next year's trees.

Christmas food

It's estimated that we throw away over 7 million tons of food every year.

If you've got a compost bin in your garden you can throw in all those veg peelings.

Presents

If you receive any presents that you can't use or have old things that you don't need, don't throw them away. There's lots of charities out there who will donate gifts to people in need.
