

TYPES OF COMPARISON. SENTENCES

POSITIVE:

(The characteristic is expressed in a neutral way)
This dog is tall.

COMPARATIVE:

(Compare two things)

.- Comparative of equality:

as + adjective + as... (tan + ... + como)

The boy is as tall as the girl.

.- Comparative of inferiority:

less + adjective + than... (menos + ... + que)

The boy is less tall than the girl.

.- Comparative of superiority:

comparative adjective + than... (más + ... + que)

The boy is taller than the girl.

The book is more interesting than the movie.

SUPERLATIVE:

(Compare more than two things. Compare with the rest)

the + superlative adjective + of/in... (el más + ... + de)

My friend is the tallest in the class.

My friend is the most intelligent in the class
