1. Sandy has 30 orange balloons. Benny has 6 times more orange balloons than Sandy. How many orange balloons does Benny have?

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2. There are 17 children in the classroom. Each student will get 33 pencils. How many pencils will the teacher have to give out?

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3. In all, 30,436 people went skiing in February and January. 16,009 went skiing in February. How many fewer people went skiing in January than February?

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4. James likes to collect coins. James got 30 coins from his brother, 38 coins from his mother as well as 25 coins from Bishop. However, James lost 26 coins before putting those coins into his piggybank. How many coins does James have in his piggybank?

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5. Bianca wants 108 cupcakes for her party. She has already made 36 chocolate cupcakes and 24 vanilla cupcakes. How many more cupcakes does Bianca need to make.

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
