

1. Some oranges are in a basket. Mark takes 3. So, 12 oranges are left in the basket. How many oranges were in the basket at the start?



$$12 + 3 = 15$$

2. 15 people are on the bus. At a bus stop, 5 people get off and 2 people get on. How many people are on the bus now?

a)  $15 - 5 = 10$       b)  $15 + 5 = 20$

3. Mary has 60 pesos. She buys a chocolate that costs 30 pesos. How many pesos does Mary have left?
