


Circulatory system

The **circulatory system** is made up of the heart and thousand of tubes called **arteries** and **veins**. The **blood** travels through arteries and veins and **carries oxygen and nutrients to all parts of the body**.



The **heart** is made up of four sections: the left and right **atriums**, and the left and right **ventricles**.



It is a hard working muscle that **pumps** blood to every parts of the body.

They return blood to the heart. This blood is **darker** (usually look blue) because they have **low oxygen**.

They **take the oxygen** we need to live.

They carry **bright red** blood full of **oxygen** from the heart to all the parts of the body.
