

SPELLING OF THE PAST SIMPLE FORM OF REGULAR VERBS (-ed)

1. Regular verbs that end in '-e', add -d.

Example: close - closed

2. Regular verbs ending in a consonant + '-y', change the '-y' to an '-i' and add '-ed'.

Example: carry - carried

3. Regular verbs ending in a vowel + a consonant (not '-y'), double the consonant and add '-ed'.

Example: stop - stopped

4. Add '-ed' to all the other regular verbs
