


MIXED NUMBERS TO IMPROPER FRACTIONS

Example: 

$$2 \frac{2}{8} = \frac{18}{8}$$

1st (multiply 8 x 2 = 16)

Directions: Match the mixed number to the improper fraction.

$3 \frac{1}{5}$	$\frac{25}{12}$
$2 \frac{6}{12}$	$\frac{17}{9}$
$1 \frac{2}{9}$	$\frac{30}{12}$
$2 \frac{1}{12}$	$\frac{11}{9}$
$1 \frac{8}{9}$	$\frac{16}{5}$
