We use the present continuous for definite future plans. We usually use a future time expression.

· We're meeting at seven o'clock.

We use will / won't to make predictions.

· When I'm 30, I'll travel around the world.

We use **be going to** to talk about **intentions**. I'm going to visit my grandparents in the summer holidays.
