

REVISION PAST SIMPLE / PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE (PPT 1)

1. GIVING NEWS: Choose the correct option and complete the examples.

-When we give some news but we don't mention when it happened, we use *PAST SIMPLE / PRESENT PERFECT*.

Ex. 1. I (buy) a new house.

-When we mention when, and the period of time has finished, we use *PAST SIMPLE / PRESENT PERFECT*.

Ex. 2. We (have) 5 exams **last week**.

-When we mention when, but the period of time has not finished, we use *PAST SIMPLE / PRESENT PERFECT*.

-Ex. 3. We (have) 5 exams **this week**.

-When we ask when, where, why, how ... something happened, we use *PAST SIMPLE / PRESENT PERFECT*.

Ex. When (you / see) the paranormal activity.

2. BEEN TO / GONE TO

Choose the correct answer:

-Mark **has been** / **has gone** to the bank this morning. (He is back home)

-Where is Mark? He **has been** / **has gone** to the bank. He won't be long.
