1. **You had better**=(You'd better) + **동사원형**: 너 ~하는 게 좋을걸 (안해봐, 어떻게 되는지!)

- a. You'd better listen up. (해석)
- b. You'd better go home and stay there. (해석)
- c. You better watch out. (해석)
- d. 너 게임 그만하고 시험공부 하는 게 좋을걸. (영작) (for your test / stop playing)

2. **You had better not** **동사원형**: 너 ~하지 않는 게 좋을걸

- a. You'd better not lie to me. (해석)
- b. You'd better not be late for school. (해석)
- c. You better not pout. (해석)
- d. 너 나한테 까불지 않는 게 좋을 거야. (fool around(mess around))

3. **For goodness sake!**: 제발, 아무쪼록

* goodness: 선량함, God을 대체하는 말로 쓰여요.

(1) Oh, my god! → Oh, my goodness. 어머니 세상에!

ex. Oh, my goodness! Long time no see! How have you been?"

“어머니, 정말 오랫동안이네요. 그 동안 어떻게 지내셨어요?”

(2) Goodness gracious! 세상에, 깜짝이야.

(3) Thank god! → Thank goodness! 어찌면 감사하게도!, 어머니, 감사해라!
