

PRESENT PERFECT + Verb Behaviour and Features

1 Richard and Suzy are talking about where to go on holiday. Read the first part of their conversation. Specify the type of each underlined verb (lexical/auxiliary/modal) and all other requested *markers* of VERB TENSE, form (*infinitive, past participle*), person, etc. Be careful with contracted forms!

Example 1:

S: This holiday in Australia sounds fantastic!
