



ZERO CONDITIONALS

1. Read and analyze the following grammar tip:

Zero conditionals are used for facts that are generally **true** and **do not change**. It refers to a general situation that **always** happens if a condition is met.



The position of the clauses does not change the meaning.



Remember: Do **not** use **comma (,)** to separate the two clauses if the result clause is first.
