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Over 150 balloons will be floating over Bristol in August – it's sure to be a breathtaking sight. The International Balloon Fiesta at Bristol is a unique event and becoming more popular every year. Balloonists from all around the world will be here for three days. They'll be two spectacular takeoffs at 6am and 6pm on day of the Fiesta. Some balloons take only a single pilot while others can carry up eight passengers. You can also see an original, old-fashioned balloon being inflated and by gas -a process which costs £4,000. Also on site will be clowns and stalls, as well as a funfair and helicopter rides. A preview is being at Durham Downs, Bristol, on July 28, when the balloons are laid out for inspection. At they will take off together with the flames from the burners lighting up the balloons and making them glow in the night as they rise into the air.
