### -AR regular verb endings

(Yo)	<b>-o</b>	(Nosotr@s)	<b>-amos</b>
(Tú)	<b>-as</b>	(Vosotr@s)	<b>-áis</b>
(Usted) (él/ ella) (1 cosa)	<b>-a</b>	(Ustedes) (ell@s) (2+ cosas)	<b>-an</b>

### Verbos con -AR: Verbs with -AR

Hablar: to listen / to talk \_\_\_\_\_

Tocar: to clean / to touch \_\_\_\_\_

Escuchar: to listen / to travel \_\_\_\_\_

Tomar: to rest / to take \_\_\_\_\_

Esperar: to wait / to talk \_\_\_\_\_

Cantar: to sing / to buy \_\_\_\_\_

Limpiar: to clean / to listen \_\_\_\_\_

Lavar: to need / to wash \_\_\_\_\_

Cocinar: to cook / to watch \_\_\_\_\_

Bailar: to dance / to work \_\_\_\_\_

Buscar: to look for / to wait \_\_\_\_\_

Comprar: to sing / to buy \_\_\_\_\_

Trabajar: to work / to study \_\_\_\_\_

Viajar: to watch / to travel \_\_\_\_\_

Necesitar: to need / to take \_\_\_\_\_

Estudiar: to study / to rest \_\_\_\_\_

Descansar: to rest / to dance \_\_\_\_\_

Mirar: to watch / to work \_\_\_\_\_

To conjugate regular –AR verbs in the present tense, take off the –ar and add the appropriate ending, based on the subject (the do-er of the action).

I dance = **Bailar** >>> **Bailo**

They travel = **Viajar** >>> **Viajan**

To make a sentence negative, put “no” in front of the conjugated verb.

I *don't* dance = **No bailo**

They *don't* travel = **No viajan**
