

Alexander's family moved to Canada.

At the age of 30 Bell got married to his deaf student Mabel Hubbard.

At the age of 75 he died in Canada due to complications from diabetes.

He left the Royal High School in Edinburgh, Scotland.

A skilled electrician Thomas Watson became Bell's assistant.

"School of Vocal Physiology and Mechanics of Speech" in Boston was founded by Bell.
