Musical Instruments

Guitars, violins, and lutes are stringed instruments. A violin has four strings. To play a violin, musicians use a long, thin piece of wood called a bow. They move the bow against the strings to make music. A guitar has six strings, and a lute has 15 or 24 strings! Musicians can play the guitar and lute with their fingers.

Pianos and keyboards are percussion instruments. A piano has 88 keys. There are 52 white keys and 36 black keys. On a small keyboard, there are 25 keys. A big keyboard has 88, like a piano! Pianos and keyboards can make loud sounds or soft, quiet sounds.

Trumpets and flutes are wind instruments. Musicians blow into a trumpet or a flute to make music. Trumpets can make very loud sounds. Flutes make a softer, sweeter sound. Which instrument would you like to play?
