Smartphones are a great invention. There are lots of applications you can have for less than £5. Here are some fun apps for children or adults.

A Curious George's Town (£2.49)

Children (4 years old and older) organise the vegetables in the market, learn the alphabet in the library and help recycle in the park. They win coins (not real ones!) which they can save or use to build their town and buy farm animals (and dinosaurs).

C The Shape Monster (free)

This game is for children aged two and up, and it helps them to learn the shapes. The Shape Monster is a friendly but hungry monster. He tells the children what shape he wants to eat and they give it to him. There are two levels for different ages.
