Writing: Paragraphs

To help a reader understand or follow your story or composition, a writer divides the information into parts called **paragraphs**. A paragraph is a group of sentences that work together to tell about a single topic or idea. Each new paragraph is set off from the others by its first line which is **indented** (a space between the left margin and first word).

A paragraph is made up of a **topic sentence** which is usually the first sentence, **three detail sentences** that tell us more about the topic sentence, and a **concluding sentence** that restates the main idea.

Read the sample paragraph below, then compose your own paragraph using one of the prompts that follow. Be sure to give your paragraph a topic.
