groups organized in the 1700s to keep colonists informed of important events	A war fought by Great Britain and the British Colonies from 1754-63 against the French and Indians to gain control of land west of the colonies
the official document by the Second Continental Congress explaining why the colonies were breaking away from England	a war fought from 1775–1783 initiated by delegates from the thirteen American colonies in Congress against Great Britain over their objection to Parliament's taxation policies and lack of colonial representation
the governing body by which the American colonial governments coordinated their resistance to British rule during the first two years of the American Revolution	a 1773 protest against British taxes in which colonists dumped tea into Boston Harbor
to refuse to do business or have contact with a person, group, country, or product	the army created by the Second Continental Congress with George Washington as commander-in-chief
a member of an elected assembly	group of persons and land that belong to another nation
