Time expressions: yesterday, last week, two years ago, in 1991 ...

Are the verbs **regular** or **irregular**?

**Irregular** verbs are in the table of irregular verbs. You can find them.

**Regular** verbs aren't there. Add +ed.

I **lost** my key yesterday. (lose) (**irregular**, from the table)

I **visited** Grandma two days ago. (visit) (**regular**, +ed)
