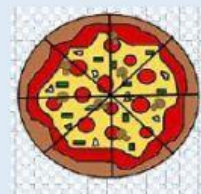
1. Mark ran $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. Tony ran $\frac{5}{8}$ of a mile. Who ran further?
