Two-syllable adjectives



honest - more honest	famous - more famous
happy - happier	crazy - crazier
narrow - narrower	gentle - gentler

Three or more syllables

expensive - more expensive	dangerous - more dangerous
popular - more popular	beautiful - more beautiful
confident - more confident	difficult - more difficult

Irregular adjectives



good - better	many - more
bad - worse	little - less
