READING COMPREHENSION - 6 MAIN IDEA AND SUPPORTING DETAILS PRACTICE WORKSHEET

The main idea of a story or an article is the most important idea about the topic - the point the writer wants you to understand and remember. In some paragraphs and articles, the main idea is stated in a topic sentence. The topic sentence often, but not always, appears at the beginning of a piece of writing. When you know the main idea, you are much more likely to remember what you have read.

The supporting details in a paragraph or article are sentences that tell about or support the main idea. Supporting details are small pieces of information that help you better understand the main idea.
