He led a march against poverty and injustice in Morant Bay and was hanged as punishment.

He was a lawyer who fought for the rights of the poor and encouraged Paul Bogle and his followers, to stand up for their rights against poverty and injustice.

This person defeated British soldiers and led a group of African slaves to freedom.

This lawyer fought for our Independence from British rule and for the right of all Jamaicans to vote for their leaders.

He created groups called "**trade unions**" to stand up for the rights of workers who were not being paid fairly.

This hero taught Black people that they were important; that they should know where they came from, be confident and believe in themselves.

This hero led other slaves in a "sit out", where they refused to work on **Christmas Day**. This likely forced the British to finally put an end to slavery.
