SA: Agree.

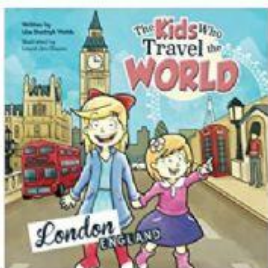
You: Ask about the price.
