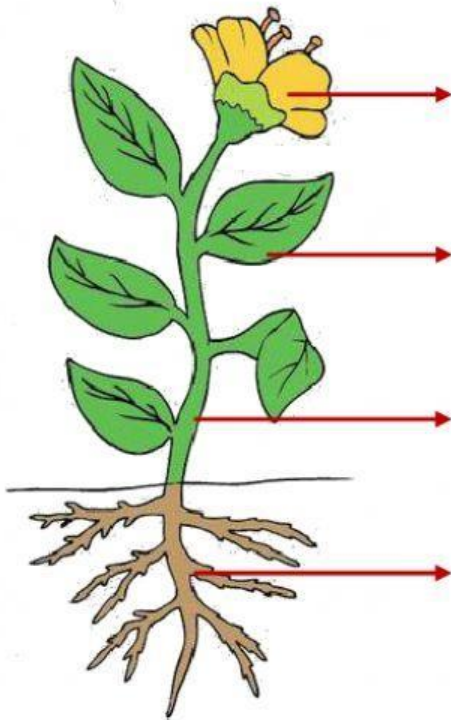


UNIT 4: PLANTS

Characteristics of plants

Plants are **living things**. They **need soil, water, air** and **sunlight** to **grow**. **Let's** see the parts of the plants.

PARTS OF A PLANT



Flower

The flowers are **colourful** and produce **seeds** for the reproduction of the plant.

Leaves

The leaves take air and sunlight to **make** food for the plant.

Stem

The stem **holds** the plant **up**.

Roots

The roots **take** water and minerals from the soil.

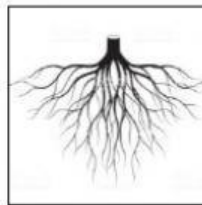

Types of plant

There are different types of plant: **grasses**, **bushes** and **trees**. Let's see it!

Grass



They are **thin**
and flexible.

Bush



They are **short**
and have **low**
branches.

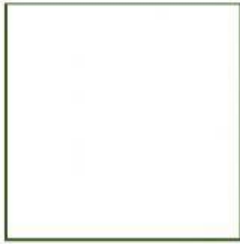


Tree



They have a **thick**
and **hard** stem
called **trunk**.

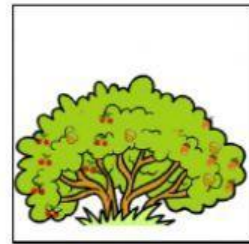
It's thin and flexible.
