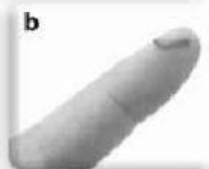

Africa is very popular with tourists. Millions of people visit Africa every year. Some people say it's the most beautiful place on Earth.

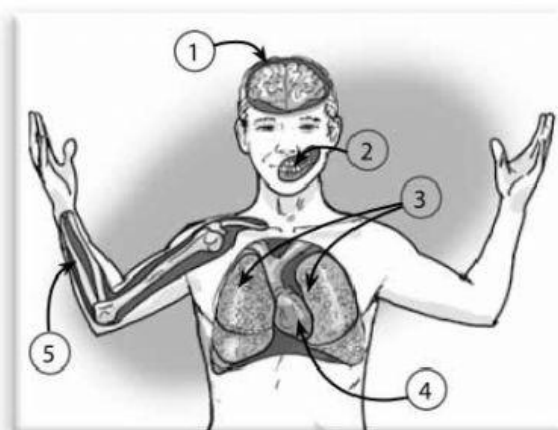
