| <input type="checkbox"/> | astern            | raised part at the bow used as a shelter for the anchor, winches etc |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | bow               | in front of the ship                                                 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | bridge            | on the left side                                                     |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | forecastle        | towards the bow, at/near the bow                                     |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | forward           | the rear of a vessel                                                 |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | port              | the left rear part of a ship                                         |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | port bow          | behind the ship                                                      |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | port quarter      | small powerful special duty vessel that can tow ships                |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | starboard         | left front part of a ship                                            |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | starboard bow     | on the right side                                                    |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | starboard quarter | part of the superstructure where the navigation takes place          |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | stern             | the front part of a vessel                                           |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | tug               | the right front part of a ship                                       |

\*NOTE: where you see 'right' or 'left' it is understood 'right/left' when you are standing at the stern looking forward
