Endangered Animals

Beluga whale are the beautiful white whales of the Arctic. The word 'beluga' comes from Russia word 'bielo' meaning white, however, these white whales are born dark gray. They can take up to eight years before they turn completely white. The belugas can swim backwards. Their dives may last up to 25 minutes and can reach depth of 880 meters.

They are endangered because of climate change, hunting, oil and gas development and pollution. Besides, polar bears and killer whales may catch belugas for food.
