FUTURE TENSES

FUTURE SIMPLE (ΑΠΛΟΣ ΜΕΛΛΟΝΤΑΣ)

FORM : will + bare infinitive

1. Χρησιμοποιούμε τον future simple για να κάνουμε προβλέψεις ή δηλώσεις.
Everyone says he will be famous one day.
2. Για αποφάσεις που παίρνουμε τη στιγμή που μιλάμε.
It's hot. I'll turn on the air conditioning.
3. Για προσφορές, προτάσεις ή παρακλήσεις.
I'll do the shopping for you.
Will you help me move this box?
4. Για να κάνουμε προβλέψεις και υποθέσεις ή για να προειδοποιήσουμε.
Get some sleep or you'll feel tired tomorrow.
5. για να πούμε τι νομίζουμε ότι θα συμβεί χρησιμοποιώντας λέξεις όπως: know, expect, be sure, suppose, probably, maybe



FUTURE CONTINUOUS (ΜΕΛΛΟΝΤΑΣ ΔΙΑΡΚΕΙΑΣ)

FORM : will be + -ing

Για να μιλήσουμε για πράξεις που θα βρίσκονται σε εξέλιξη σε μια συγκεκριμένη στιγμή στο μέλλον.

e.g. This time next month, the band will be performing live in London.

Will you be having lunch with Daniel tomorrow?

FUTURE PERFECT (ΣΥΝΤΕΛΕΣΜΕΝΟΣ ΜΕΛΛΟΝΤΑΣ)

FORM : will have + past participle

Για πράξεις που θα έχουν ολοκληρωθεί σε μια συγκεκριμένη στιγμή στο μέλλον.

e.g. By 10 o'clock, the play will have finished.

Will the hotel have opened by the beginning of May?

BE GOING TO (= Πρόκειται να...)

FORM : be going to + bare infinitive

1. Για να μιλήσουμε για σχέδια, προθέσεις ή αποφάσεις που έχουμε πάρει για το μέλλον.

e.g. We're going to visit our cousins next weekend.

Is Paul going to buy a new computer?

2. Για να κάνουμε προβλέψεις για το μέλλον που βασίζονται σε πράγματα που γνωρίζουμε ή που μπορούμε να δούμε στο παρόν.

e.g. Look at the time! You are going to miss the bus.

There isn't a cloud in the sky, so it isn't going to rain.

PRESENT SIMPLE

Για να αναφερθούμε σε δρομολόγια και προγράμματα στο μέλλον.

e.g. The train doesn't leave until 7.30 tonight.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Με μελλοντική σημασία για πράγματα που έχουμε προγραμματίσει να κάνουμε στο μέλλον.

e.g. We aren't going to the beach tomorrow.
