NEG.	There aren't		any ...		
INTERROG.	Are there		any ...		

AFFIRM.	There is	}	some ...	}	+ Uncountable Nouns (always singular!)
NEG.	There isn't		any ...		
INTERROG.	Is there		any ...		



REMEMBER! Uncountable nouns **DON'T** have plural form.
