

Present Perfect Simple

Present perfect. Prošlo vrijeme koje koristimo kada želimo:

- naglasiti posljedice neke radnje
- radnja koja je počela u prošlosti i nije završila, naglasiti da se nešto dogodilo u razdoblju u kojem se nalazimo (npr. danas, a ne jučer)
- iskustva koja se mogu ponoviti.

Tvorba: *glagol have ili has + 3. stupac u tablici nepravilnih glagola ili pravilni glagol-ed*

I **have played** football.

We **have played** football.

You **have played** football.

You **have played** football.

She / he/it **has played** football.

They **have played** football.

Negacijski oblik:

I **haven't played** football.

We **haven't played** football.

You **haven't played** football.

You **haven't played** football.

She / he/it **hasn't played** football.

They **haven't played** football.

Upitni oblik:

Have I **played** football?

Have we **played** football?

Have you **played** football?

Have you **played** football?

Has he/she/it **played** football?

Have they **played** football?

Riječi koje koristimo uz present perfect:

- **ever** – ikad (*Have you ever played football?*)
- **never** – nikad (*I have never played football.*)
- **for** – koliko dugo se nešto događa (*I have been playing football for two hours.*)
- **since** – od kada se nešto događa (*I have been playing football since 9 o'clock.*)
- **just** – upravo (*I have just finished playing.*)
- **yet** – još – s pitanjima i negacijama (*Have you been to Rome yet? I haven't been there yet.*)
