Rule:

Also comes **after the verb be (is, are, am, was, were)** and **before other verbs**:
*He's **also** in the Portuguese national team. He **also** won the Club World Cup.*

They lost against Liverpool. ➡ They lost also / also lost against Arsenal.

He is good at singing. ➡ He's also / He also is good at dancing.

We visited London. ➡ We also went / went also to Oxford.

His old video game was boring. ➡ It also was / was also very easy.
