Rule:

Also comes **after the verb be** (is, are, am, was, were) and **before other verbs**:

*He's also in the Portuguese national team. He **also** won the Club World Cup.*

They lost against Liverpool. → They lost also / also lost against Arsenal.

He is good at singing. → He's also / He also is good at dancing.

We visited London. → We also went / went also to Oxford.

His old video game was boring. → It also was / was also very easy.
