The present simple is used to talk about everyday actions or habits. It is also used to talk about general truths.

AFFIRMATIVE FORM +

I	am
You	are
He	is
She	is
It	is
We	are
They	are

NEGATIVE FORM -

I	am not
You	are not / aren't
He	is not / isn't
She	is not / isn't
It	is not / isn't
We	are not / aren't
They	are not / aren't

INTERROGATIVE FORM ?

Am	I	?
Are	you	?
Is	he	?
Is	she	?
Is	It	?
Are	we	?
Are	they	?
