


- I /he/she/it **wasn't** + glagol+ **-ing** *I wasn't playing the piano.*
We/You/They **weren't** *We weren't swimming.*

? **Was** I /he/she/it + glagol+ **-ing** *Was I watching TV?*
Were we/you/they *Were you swimming?*
