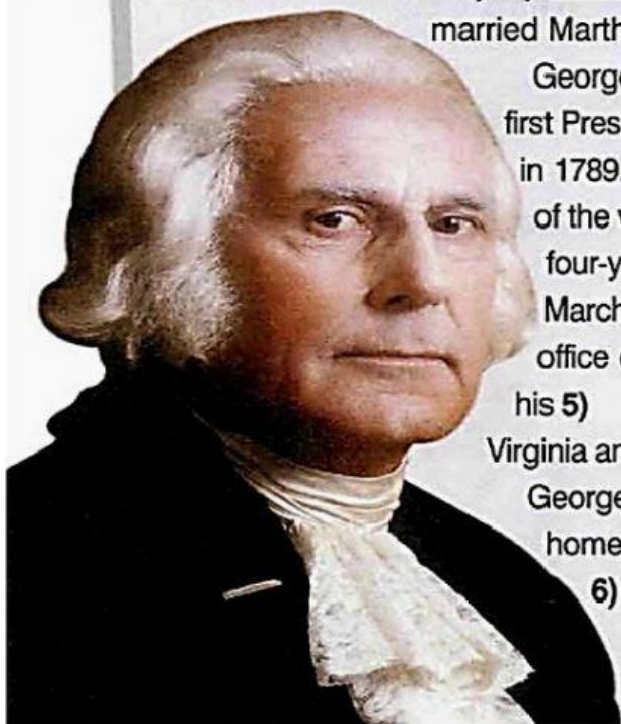
George Washington was born on 22nd February, 1) _____, in Westmoreland County, Virginia, in the USA.
