
Mother. At campfires you can meet other Brownies, sing songs and play games. Being a Brownie is a lot of fun.

I have my own keyboard and I play for at least ten minutes each day. I find that the more I practise, the better I can play. One must be well disciplined and practise regularly in order to perform well.



#### Soccer


My favourite game is soccer. I think I can play this game well because I have strong leg muscles and I can
