The chorus sets the scene as Verona where two \_\_\_\_\_ (1) the Montagues and the Capulets, feud<sup>1</sup>. The play then erupts onto the streets of \_\_\_\_\_ (2) and the brawl<sup>2</sup> between the families. The Prince of Verona intervenes to \_\_\_\_\_ (3) the fighting and old Capulet agrees to betroth<sup>3</sup> his daughter, Juliet, to the Prince's young kinsman<sup>4</sup>, Paris. Old Capulet arranges a masked ball to \_\_\_\_\_ (4).

Young Romeo Montague and his friends, including the witty Mercutio, sneak into the ball to get a glimpse of Rosaline Capulet, the object of Romeo's unrequited<sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_. (5). Instead, Romeo meets Juliet Capulet, Rosaline's cousin, and is overwhelmed by her \_\_\_\_\_. (6). Later that night, Romeo, lingering<sup>6</sup> below Juliet's \_\_\_\_\_ (7), overhears Juliet's avowal<sup>7</sup> of love for \_\_\_\_\_. (8).

He makes himself known to her and the pair resolve to \_\_\_\_\_ (9), the following night. Friar Laurence and Juliet's nurse agree to help them, hoping the union will \_\_\_\_\_ (10) the feud. Romeo and Juliet are secretly married by \_\_\_\_\_ (11). The next day, Mercutio taunts<sup>8</sup> Tybalt Capulet, Juliet's cousin, a hot-tempered young man, and the two begin to fence<sup>9</sup>. Romeo tries to break up the fight but Tybalt fatally wounds Mercutio. Romeo kills Tybalt in revenge and the Prince \_\_\_\_\_ (12), Romeo from \_\_\_\_\_ (13), to \_\_\_\_\_ (14). Romeo and Juliet spend their wedding night together before Romeo flees<sup>10</sup> to Mantua. Juliet's wedding to Paris is arranged.

Desperate, Juliet asks Friar Laurence for help. He advises her to take a sleeping potion which will make her seem \_\_\_\_\_ (15), for \_\_\_\_\_. (16). The Friar will send a message to Romeo in Mantua so can then rescue her from the family tomb when she awakens. Juliet goes ahead with the plan and is found, apparently dead, in her \_\_\_\_\_ (17). The Friar's message does not reach Romeo, and he hears only of Juliet's \_\_\_\_\_. (18).

Grief-stricken, Romeo rushes back to Verona and creeps into the Capulet tomb where he meets Paris. The two fight and Paris is \_\_\_\_\_. (19). Romeo lays down besides Juliet's body, takes poison, and dies. Not long after, Juliet regains consciousness and finds Romeo dead. Heartbroken, she tries to take the poison from his \_\_\_\_\_ (20) with a kiss but death alludes<sup>11</sup> her. So she stabs herself and dies. As the bodies are discovered, Friar Laurence explains the story to the Prince, who lambastes<sup>12</sup> the families whose feuding has brought about this tragedy. Horrified by the sorry situation the Montagues and the Capulets end their feud.
