

Grammar Pronouns

Pronouns are words that can replace nouns.

Sometimes a pronoun replaces the subject of the sentence and we call those **SUBJECT PRONOUNS**.

The boys worked hard in the yard. (NOUN)

They worked hard in the yard. (PRONOUN)

Pronouns that are not the subject in a sentence are **OBJECT PRONOUNS**.

The boys give the ripe fruits to **the children**. (NOUN)

The boys give the fruits to **them**. (PRONOUN)
