Pubs, restaurants, gyms and cinemas across London will (1) _____ ordered to close as part of the capital's efforts to contain the coronavirus outbreak, it has been reported. The drastic measures are set to be announced (2) _____ Boris Johnson later this afternoon at his daily news conference. The capital has been badly hit by the Covid-19 outbreak and the move is a massive ramping up of social distancing measures. It is believed 58 (3) _____ of the 144 fatal cases have been in London as the city is several weeks ahead of the pandemic's curve compared to the rest (4) _____ the UK.

Mr Johnson chaired an emergency Cobra meeting this morning (5) _____ decide on the effective shutdown of the hospitality industry. Shops deemed as 'non-essential' stores could also be (6) _____ to stop customers handling goods and then passing (7) _____ the virus.
