Pubs, restaurants, gyms and cinemas across London will (1) ordered
to close as part of the capital's efforts to contain the coronavirus outbreak, it has
been reported. The drastic measures are set to be announced (2) Boris
Johnson later this afternoon at his daily news conference. The capital has been
badly hit by the Covid-19 outbreak and the move is a massive ramping up of social
distancing measures. It is believed 58 (3) of the 144 fatal cases have
been in London as the city is several weeks ahead of the pandemic's curve
compared to the rest (4) the UK.
Mr Johnson chaired an emergency Cobra meeting this morning (5)
decide on the effective shutdown of the hospitality industry. Shops deemed as
'non-essential' stores could also be (6) to stop customers handling
goods and then passing (7) the virus.
Until now, Mr Johnson had only advised Britons to avoid pubs (8) other
social gatherings. But there were concerns people (9) ignoring these
measures and continuing to meet in groups. Health Secretary Matt Hancock this
morning appealed for more people to stay (10) home. He said:
'(11) you stay at home, you are saving lives. 'I know, of course, this is a
(12) dangerous disease for older people but not exclusively, some
young people get it too.' The anticipated move follows Transport for London
saying it will close (13) to 40 London Underground stations until further
notice. The Night Tube, (14) normally operates on Friday and
Saturday nights, (15) also been suspended.
