EXCEPTIONS: TO BE /TO HAVE (got)							
I	Am	I	Am not	Am	I...?	Yes, I am	No, I'm not
We, you, they	Are	We, you, they	Aren't	Are	We, you, they...?	Yes, (We, you, they) are	No, (We, you, they) Aren't
He, she, it	Is	He, she, it	Isn't	Is	He, she, it...?	Yes, (He, she, it) is	No, (He, she, it) Isn't
