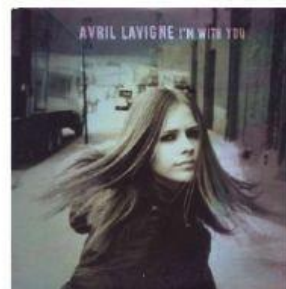


## I'M WITH YOU, Avril Lavigne
